What is Buoy Health?

Buoy Health (pronounced boo-E) develops web-based symptom checkers that help take the guesswork out of healthcare. It allows users to research *what do I have* and *what should I do about it.*

What is the COVID-19 symptom checker?

The COVID-19 symptom checker provides UnitedHealth Group employees and family members with a tool configured to support individual needs related to COVID-19, including personalized information and care recommendations based on the latest CDC guidance.

How is the COVID-19 symptom checker kept up-to-date?

The Buoy Health full-time clinical team reviews and updates internal rules regularly, sometimes daily, to ensure that users are receiving guidance in line with the latest CDC research and guidelines around COVID-19.

Who can use this product?

The COVID-19 symptom checker is available at no cost to US based UnitedHealth Group employees.

How does it work?

- To start, simply enter symptoms.
- The COVID-19 symptom checker is designed to feel like you're chatting with a doctor.
- The COVID-19 symptom checkers algorithm then analyzes answers in real-time and decides the most important question to ask next.
- In less than a minute, the COVID-19 symptom checker is able to understand the case in detail and analyze the risk for COVID-19.
- The COVID-19 symptom checker will then make a care level recommendation.
